




Fixtures and Results

- > Take care with the October Half Term
- > Rule 20 (A) allows one fixture break for 'any reason' NB 21 days notice needed.
- > Rule 20 (C) Home Teams responsibility to inform the Away Team of match details in a timely manner
- > Rule 21 (B) Both Teams responsibility of reporting Results in a timely manner (County and League)
- > Rule 21 (B) The need to report any cancellations or delays as soon as they are aware.

The Playing Season - Fixture Breaks

You can request a fixture break ONLY if

- you give 21 days advance notice in writing to the League Secretary by submitting a fully completed TAN9 form
 - and ONLY if
- 2) One of the following situations applies
- (a) A school trip or club tour has been arranged which prevents the team from fielding a squad of at least the number of players which constitutes a full 'team'.
- OR (b) Any other situation, of which 21 days advance notice has been given,

MINI SOCCER LAW 12 - Fouls etc.

For Under 7s to Under 9s (2024/25 season)

Deliberately heading the ball is an offence punishable by an indirect free kick.

The indirect free kick is taken at the point

where the ball was deliberately headed,

except:



MINI SOCCER LAW 12 - Fouls etc

For Under 7s to Under 9s (2024/25 season) Where a player deliberately heads the ball within their own penalty area, the referee will stop the game and restart with an indirect free kick to the opposition from the nearest side line of the penalty area where the offence took place.



MINI SOCCER LAW 15

Pass or Dribble-in for Under 7s to Under 9s

- When the whole of the ball passes over the touchline, on the ground or in the air, instead of a throw-in, a pass-in or dribble-in is awarded.
- A kicker taking a pass-in may choose to touch the ball again before it is touched by another player.
- At the moment of delivering the ball:
- The ball must be stationary on the touchline at the point where it left the pitch; only the kicker may be off the pitch.



MINI SOCCER LAW 15

Pass or Dribble-in for Under 7s to Under 9s

- All opponents must stand at least 5 yards from the point on the touchline where the pass-in or dribble-in is to be taken.
- A goal cannot be scored directly from a pass-in.
- The ball is in play when it is kicked and clearly moves.

U10s only in 2024/25: Normal throw-ins are allowed.

Sin Bins for **DISSENT**





HOW DO YOU FIND YOURSELF IN THE SIN BIN?



Players will only go into the sin bin for dissent cautions



For use of words, gestures, questioning or undermining the referee's decisions



EXAMPLES OF DISSENT:

Shouting at the referee, questioning the referee's ability, slamming the ball into the ground and sarcastically clapping a decision



6) REFEREES

Sin Bins for DISSENT

DURATION OF A SIN BIN



For matches of 90 minutes, players spend 10 minutes in the sin bin



For matches of all other lengths, players spend 8 minutes in the sin bin



If the sin bin period has not expired at the end of:

1st half: Continues into the 2nd half
2nd half: Continues into extra time
Extra time: Players can participate in the penalty shoot out



6) Sin Bins for DISSENT

THE MATCH DAY PROCESS





Dissent

Dissent caution: Referee issues a Yellow Card and directs the player to the touchline Whilst in the sin bin, if the player commits a Yellow or Red Card offence they are sent off and can not be substituted

A player can only return to the field of play with the referee's permission at a stoppage in play If a player receives a second Yellow Card for any type of offence, they will be shown a Red Card and dismissed from the field of play

Offensive, insulting or abusive language and/or actions is still a RED Card offence





7) Match Cards and the APP


All teams are encouraged by the League to appoint 3 people to use the APP for each team. A responsible parent/guardian who regularly attends on matchdays may be identified as a team administrator. They do not need to be DBS checked to assume this position.



7) RENEW ACCESS to use the APP

Because all existing teams have now migrated up a year, ALL Manager's, Assistants' or Admin's Matchday Apps will require a **new code**, specific to this seasons teams. **Club Secretaries can resend** the new 8 digit code to their managers through

"My Club" - "Club Details" - and then select the App option; then select the "action" button below each managers or assistant managers name; then "Send Email".

So just who is Responsible?


- How you behave and how you control your team and supporters sets the tone for the match and your club.
